LEAD Forest School works in partnership with the Lumley Estate and Wynyard Hall. These beautiful venues offer seclusion, tranquillity and peaceful surroundings in which our learners will enjoy nature as well as offering a safe and secure learning environment.

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## Activities can include:-

## **STEVE** Director of LEAD Forest School

Steve has a BA (Hons) in Sport & Outdoor Education, a PGCE and completed the Graduate Teacher Programme (GTP). He was head of sport in an Ofsted 'outstanding' SEN school based in Sunderland. # FOREST SCHOOL VENUES



## Wynyard Hall TS22 5NF (Follow signs for Gardens & Grand Marquee)

Surrounded by 150 acres of historical landscape, you'll find it hard to beat the sense of tranquillity that encompasses Wynyard Hall. To reach our site you will easily navigate your way through the beautiful Woodland Walk until you reach the famous 'Eagle Bridge'. From there our Forest School leaders will walk you through the ancient woods to our site, identifying edible plants and even track animals such as badgers and deer along the way.

Our Wynyard woodland site offers total seclusion and peaceful surroundings to enjoy the beauty of nature and learn in a safe and secure environment.



## Lumley Estate DH3 4NU (Look out for entrance above, on A183)\*

Set in 5.5 acres of woodland on the beautiful Lumley Estate, Lead Forest School works with a range of clients including schools, education providers, charities and private companies for corporate events. Our site, 'The Ride' boasts an array of wildlife, native woodland and wonderful flora. Our Forest School leaders work within our woodland site and also operate along the river where you will see plenty of wildlife including kingfisher, heron, deer and badger. The Lumley Estate is also home to the magnificent Lumley Castle dating back to 1389 where there are stories of betrayal, war and the visits of monarchs abound.

**\*Directions:** Enter through private road, continue over bridge for parking.



## Low Resilience Support Programme

**6 DAY COURSE / £450** (3-10 learners. Groups can be made up from different schools)

The aim of this course is to support learners who have been identified as struggling to access their learning as a result of low resilience. We aim to run this specialist programme over 6 'full day' sessions. This could be delivered 1 day per week during an academic half term or during school holidays.

Through nature based activities in the woodland, learners will develop a higher level of resilience and recognise how they can learn to better manage their behaviour within the more formal classroom environment through a variety of coping mechanisms. The programme is ideal for groups between yr5 and yr9, or learners of a similar age. Our Forest School leaders will meet with the school SLT to discuss any relevant EHCP outcomes of the child and the activities we will utilise to tackle the identified issues.

Many of the tasks will have a bush craft theme and we will introduce learners to the woodland environment with minimal challenge initially. We will then aim to develop their self-belief through achievable tasks throughout the programme, minimising opportunities for 'social loafing' or quietly opting out.

On completion of the course (including the John Muir Award), as well as the celebratory day for parents and teachers, the school will also receive a detailed and individual report, including some advice on next steps, i.e. how the learner might be supported to ensure progress is sustainable back in school. The course covers 6 days of learning in the woods, a pre-course visit, end of course report, equipment, insurance and resources. The course takes place regardless of weather\* it's all part of developing resilience!

# ADHD Support Programme

**6 DAY COURSE / £800** (2-8 learners. Groups can be made up from different schools)

The aim of this course is to support complex needs learners who have a diagnosis specifically of ADHD, or display those traits. We work closely with learners in the woodland environment to show ADHD in a more positive light; after all who wants a label that has both 'deficit' and 'disorder' in it?

Typically, they will learn Bushcraft skills such as wildlife tracking and identification, fire lighting, creating craft items, modern and historic tool use, foraging, and shelter building. They will learn about their hunter-gatherer ancestors and how ADHD traits would have been extremely important to them for survival. We use these skills as a vehicle to improve their sense of self, support self-regulation and develop coping skills. We also do some guided meditation and discussions round the camp fire. Learners will also work towards the John Muir and Wild Passport Award Schemes.

For this programme to be effective, our Forest School leaders will initially meet with the school SLT and focus the discussion around any applicable EHCP outcomes for that child. We will also discuss general issues, difficulties and how the condition manifests itself in their individual case to ensure outcomes are met.

We aim to run this specialist programme over 6 full day sessions. This could be delivered 1 day per week during an academic half term or during school holidays. The programme is ideal for groups between yr5 and yr9, or learners of a similar age.

The course covers 6 days of learning in the woods, a pre-course visit, end of course report, all equipment, insurance and resources.

On completion of the course, as well as a celebratory day for teachers and parents, the school will also receive a detailed report including some advice on next steps, i.e. how the learner might be supported to ensure progress is sustainable back at school.

**LIVING HISTORY ADVENTURES**



## Cave Man Day **£480**

The Lead team will visit your school and set up our 'cave'. Children will step back in time to the Stone Age learning and discovering the 3 stone age eras; Palaeolithic, Mesolithic and Neolithic periods leading us into the Bronze Age.

Children will enjoy exploring the different periods of time, examining artefacts (replicas and actual 6000-year-old flint tools), and solving stone age mysteries. They will try their hand at fire lighting and produce their very own cave art!

We will also cover topics such as language, survival skills, religion, tool use, plants and animals. The children's senses will be stimulated through handling a range of ancient artefacts, the sights and sounds of our ancestors around the fire and the touch of the animal fur.



## Roman/Celt Day **£480**

Find out what life was really like under Roman rule! How did the people of Britain respond? How did living for centuries with an occupying force change life for them? Learners will meet a Roman legionary and his Celtic enemy.

They will learn about battle tactics, culture, beliefs and even the food they ate! They can even train as legionaries themselves and face a blood curdling charge by the Celt! A few (blunt) spears will send him packing!





## Viking/Anglo-Saxon Day **£480**

Children will love the opportunity to learn from our authentically dressed Viking and Anglo-Saxon warriors! The team will set up the tent and tarp in your grounds where they can sit on comfortable animal skins. We'll then guide the children through the Viking age in Britain from the Lindisfarne raid of 793AD to the dark days of 1066.

The children will have a truly hands on experience, including the challenge of the shield wall and sacrifices to Thor! By the end of the day they'll have a greater understanding of Viking culture, tactics and religion.
